Each school year has three terms:

Discounts:

- 5% given to Senior School Students off their tuition fees for each full year attended in the Primary School.

Note: If multiple discounts are available, the maximum cumulative discount awarded will not exceed 30%

Additional Fees

Application Fees (non-refundable)

Applicant: £50*

Tutor hours:

1:1 Tutoring during school hours £35 per hour for external students
£12 per hour for students attending the school

Uniform: See uniform price list

Optional bus fare: See bus fare price list

Year 11 Exam fees: Depending on the exam and amount of exams taken £300 - £700.

New Applicants Year 1 – Year 13:

A non-refundable deposit is required to secure your place at the school. This deposit will be credited to your first term invoice once your child has started.

- **UK Applicants:** £200, payable upon acceptance
- **International Applicants:** £500, payable upon acceptance

*For UK residence only: Those parents using government funding for children joining the preschool or reception class do not need to pay the registration fee or deposit.

Exam Fees

GCSE Exams: Generally range from **£55.00 to £95.00 per individual exam paper**, depending on the subject, exam board, and specification. Because most academic subjects require multiple papers, total costs per subject are higher.

A-Level Exams: Typically range from **£90.00 to £185.00 per exam** based on the subject and board.
